- Trisodium phosphate – CAS-no. 7601-54-9
- Sodium alginate – CAS-no. 9005-38-3
- Starch – CAS-no. 9005-25-8
- Tannin – CAS-no. 1401-55-4
- Morpholine – CAS-no. 110-91-8 (only Hydromin)

are either listed in the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Code of Federal Regulations, Title 21, Part 173, Section 173.310 – Boiler Water Additives (as of April 1, 2010), where the steam is intended to get in direct contact with food, or generally recognized as safe (GRAS).

Regarding the product Hydromin, the content of morpholine must not exceed 10 ppm in steam, and the steam is excluded from contact with milk and milk products.
